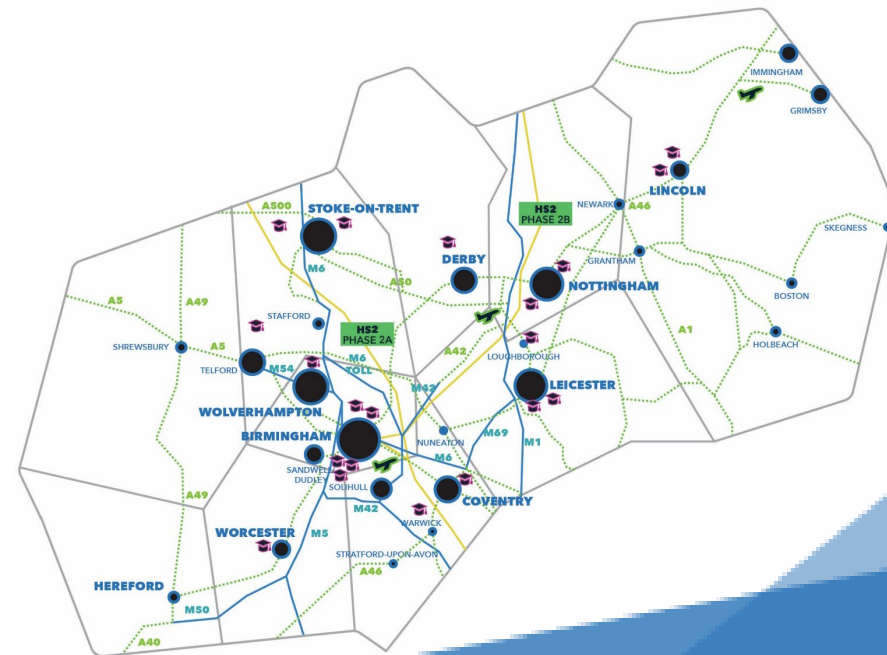

Life Sciences turnover in the Midlands was estimated at **£9.5bn** in 2019

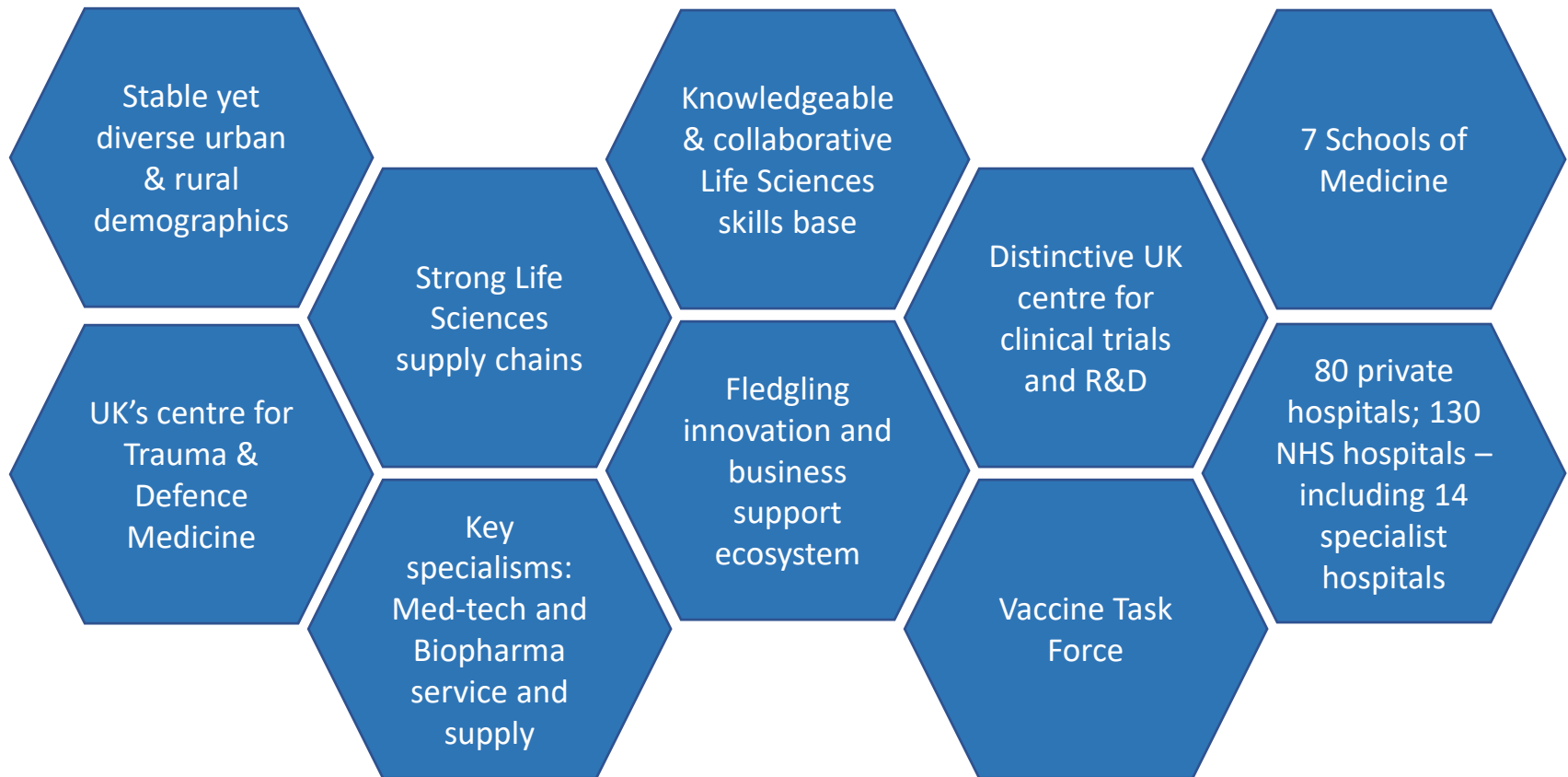
